THE SPIRITUAL WALK

We have only one objective with these short lessons, and that is to represent the word of God in a simple and truthful fashion. We use only Bible references that can indicate the power and truth contained in the "inspired word of God". Verses that add clarity to our Scriptural understanding; the verses and passages that are designed to bring us to salvation and prepare us for a daily walk with the Lord. Spiritual truth can only be determined by the word of the Almighty God, who, in his infinite wisdom has provided for us, "All things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him that hath called us to glory and virtue:" 2 Peter 1:3

As we study and otherwise review these truths, please remember a few fundamental requirements: We are not at liberty to add-to or to take-away from the writings. *Revelation 22;18-19*. The warning is given that should be taken seriously. ONLY THOSE THINGS THAT ARE DEFINED IN THE INSPIRED WORD OF GOD CAN BE USED TO IDENTIFY THE WAY AND THE WILL OF GOD! There is no place for embellishment or personal opinion. "No prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation" <u>2 Peter 1:2.</u> The holy and inspired word of God has a meaning that only God has authorized.

Prophecy came not by the will of man but Holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost." 2 Peter 1:21.
God's word was carefully composed, carefully preserved, and carefully protected. By design, it is an outline for all spiritual people for all time. It is (and was intended to be) the ultimate and only resource that spiritual people would need to learn of God; How to Understand God; How to please God. Perhaps the most crucial verse that helps to realize the intent of the word, is recorded in 2 Timothy 3:16 & 17, " All scripture is given by the inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness; That the man of God may be perfect (complete), throughly furnished unto all good works."

The location of different verses within the word of God is significant; God purposely did not provide a 2 page document that lists the do's and don'ts of righteousness. In order to get a clear understanding of the will of God, and the lessons taught the indicators of what God desires *must be discovered*. They are strategically placed (as a part of inspiration) throughout the word. It is by the design of God that every person make the effort to learn what the Bible has to say. When an individual comes to understand the value of righteousness and feels a 'spiritual need' they are drawn into the word to learn of its ways.

They Have No Dawn

he people of Judah during Isaiah's day had lived through the reigns of the good kings Uzziah and Jotham, men who revered the Lord and His word — even if the people of Judah themselves were less than faithful. But king Ahaz followed them, and he was anything but an Uzziah or Jotham. He brought paganism and occult practices into Jerusalem and Judah, which the people adopted all too quickly and gladly.

Isaiah, God's prophet, rebuked the faithless king and people...

> "When they say to you, 'Consult the mediums and the spiritists who whisper and mutter,' should not a people consult their God? Should they consult the dead on behalf of the living? To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to this (Isaiah 8:19, 20)

word, it is because they have no dawn."

The people of Judah were looking for wisdom, for reliable predictions about the future, and counsel. Of course, they were; mankind intuitively realizes that they need it — sometimes because they realize that they can't reliably know the future and sometimes because they realize that there are too many X-factors, too many variables and unknowns. But instead of looking to the Lord, they were consulting with the mediums, necromancers, spiritists, and other false or pagan prophets of their day. This was in direct disobedience to Moses' command in Deuteronomy 18:9-15.

So, Isaiah corrects their error by trying to use a little logic: "Should they consult the dead (what mediums and necromancers do) on behalf of the living?" It was, of course, a rhetorical question, demanding a firm "No!" and an enthusiastic

charge, "Back to the Bible!" — AKA, "To the law and to the testimony!"

People are still looking for wisdom, insight, and counsel, of course — and like Judah of old, looking for it in all the wrong places. It's probably no breaking news to you that people still look for such things from mediums, palm readers, and other occultists believing that they have the real answers about finance, romance, and more. But even more folks take guidance from celebrities (fame apparently bestows greater wisdom!), political

platforms, TV or radio pundits, pseudo-science, half-baked psychology, religious leaders (the less Christian, the better), social media influencers, ivory tower specialists, neighbors, and basically any one but the Lord. But somehow (aren't you surprised?) all such guidance becomes one wrong turn after anoth-

er, all such wisdom

proves itself in the end to be folly, and all such insights turn out to be the blind leading the blind they have no dawn.

Isaiah's words ring so true, "To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to this word, it is because they have no dawn." There is one truth, God's truth. The rest of it is just darkness, blindness, and deception. The only time the world finds itself in the light is when it finally agrees with the LORD.

It is when men seek wisdom from God that the dawn breaks! In the same context as Isaiah 9:19. 20 (see above) Isaiah says, "The people who walk in darkness will see a great light; those who live in a dark land, the light will shine on them" (Isaiah 9:2); and he's talking about Jesus (see Isaiah 9:6,7).

Let dawn break over the gloom! Turn to the Lord.
