The Lord's Church of which He spoke in <u>Matthew</u> <u>16:18</u> was established in the year AD 33, recorded for us in <u>Acts 2</u>. It is the Church for which Christ died, <u>Acts 20:28</u>: It is the body of believers, of which He is the head, <u>Colossians 1:18</u>: and it is the Church through which the "manifold wisdom of God" is presented <u>Ephesians 3:10</u>. There were to be no "divisions among you; all are to speak the same thing"; "that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and the same judgment." <u>1 Corinthian</u> <u>1:10</u>.

When you have a chance, look at <u>Galations 1:3ff</u>, "Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord, Jesus Christ, who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world; according to the will of God our Father: <u>V6-7.</u> I marvel that you are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ into another gospel, which <u>is</u> not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ." <u>V8.</u> "Though we or an angel from Heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed."

Does this sound like a description of what we would call "church" in this day and time? Look around you, and see the mass confusion of what otherwise would be called truth. Organizations that call themselves churches who have lost the value of moral standard from God's Holy and Divine Word, that have added-to and taken-from the original concept of truth that is expressed so clearly throughout God's Word in direct expression, and perfect example. We must trust in the Word of the Lord.

If a brother or sister is without clothing and in need of daily food, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and be filled," and yet you do not give them what is necessary for their body, what use is that? Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead, being by itself.

he story is told of a French atheist who died and willed his farm to the devil.

Needless to say, this was an unusual will that ultimately ended up in a French court to decide the disposal of the atheist's property. Interestingly enough, it was decided that the best way to carry out the wishes of the atheist was to give it over to Satan to do with it what Satan does with things. The court ordered that "nothing" be done. Thus, because nothing was done; nothing was done for his farm and very soon the farm was overgrown in weeds and briars. And nothing was done for his farmhouse either, and soon enough it was decaying and falling into ruin.

There's a great moral here. Destruction, ruin, decay, and death have been the hallmark, the fingerprint as it were, of Satan, since mankind's first encounter with him. Weeds, briars, decay, and ruin is the unavoidable fate of everything he touches in relatively short order. Every time.

And to let him in to do his worst, takes no work, no sweat—nothing. No effort required. Just do nothing.

- To lose knowledge and understanding of God's word, just do nothing.

- To gain in worldly knowledge and worldly wisdom, just do nothing.
- To lose the church's loving fellowship to apathy, just do nothing.

- To let false teachings and practices lead men away from the Lord, just do nothing.
