"WHAT THOU OUGHTEST TO DO"

One of the greatest examples of obedience is the account Cornelius in *Acts* 10. There are several things that make this account unusual in regard to finding salvation in the Christian dispensation. As a general rule, the Pharisees would affirm that "God heareth not sinners" John 9:31. This is in reference to Isaiah 59:1-2, "the Lord's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither His ear heavy that it cannot hear; but your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid His face from you, that He will not hear." To the Judean leaders, this would mean that only the prayers of the Jews would be legitimate. This was also consistent with Peter's belief in the beginning of Acts 10.

Peter was about to learn a valuable lesson at the hand of the Holy Spirit. In Acts 9: 9-16, Peter is given a 'vision' of a great sheet upon which all sorts of animals appeared with the instructions, "Arise Peter, kill and eat." Peter, understanding the Law concerning clean and unclean animals, refused the notion. He did not immediately understand the vision, but he contemplated the meaning.

If we look back at Acts 9:1-6, we see that the man, Cornelius "was a devout man that feared God with all of his house...and prayed to God always". Although he would be considered a sinner and unclean as a non-Jew, God recognized him as a soul worth saving and heard his prayers. The instruction came from the Lord in verses 5-6 to "send men to Joppa and call for one Simon, whose surname is Peter...he shall tell thee what thou oughtest to do." Cornelius was forewarned that Peter would provide the instruction in righteousness that he would need in order to be obedient to God unto salvation.

While Peter had wondered what his vision would reveal to him, it became clear when the household of Cornelius received the Holy Spirit verses 44-46. This was the undeniable sign that the Gentiles were included in the Plan of God for salvation. Had this been the final determining factor concerning the salvation of Cornelius and his household, Peter could have stopped without further comment. However, the inspired writer continues to record the instruction needed to complete the plan when he said in **verses 47-48**, "Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized... and he COMMANDED them to be baptized in the name of the Lord."

PLAIN-SPOKEN PASSAGES

ark Twain famously said, "Most people are bothered by those passages of Scripture they do not understand, but the passages that bother me are those I do understand." While Mark Twain (Samuel Clements) seems to have not been overly religious, he spoke a profound truth about paying attention to verses of Scripture that are difficult to misunderstand, and ones that ought to bring us all to sober attention.

Here's a few plain verses that are heavy with warning and meaning to anyone who cares anything at all about his soul...

- John 14:6 "Jesus *said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me."
- Matthew 7:13, 14 ""Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads

to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. "For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it."

- Galatians 1:8, 9 "But even if we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a gospel contrary to what we have preached to you, he is to be accursed! As we have said before, so I say again now, if any man is preaching to you a gospel contrary to what you received, he is to be accursed!"
- Matthew 7:21-23 ""Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; DEPART FROM ME, YOU WHO PRACTICE LAWLESSNESS.'"
