
The Gospel according to LUKE

BEATITUDES — WHAT DO THEY MEAN?

- 20 And turning His gaze toward His disciples, He began to say, "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.
- ✤ <u>21</u> "Blessed are you who hunger now, for you shall be satisfied. Blessed are you who weep now, for you shall laugh.
- 22 "Blessed are you when men hate you, and ostracize you, and insult you, and scorn your name as evil, for the sake of the Son of Man.
- ✤ <u>23</u> "Be glad in that day and leap for joy, for behold, your reward is great in heaven. For in the same way their fathers used to treat the prophets.
- ◆ <u>24</u> "But woe to you who are rich, for you are receiving your comfort in full.
- ✤ <u>25</u> "Woe to you who are well-fed now, for you shall be hungry. Woe to you who laugh now, for you shall mourn and weep.

✤ <u>26</u> "Woe to you when all men speak well of you, for their fathers used to treat the false prophets in the same way.
