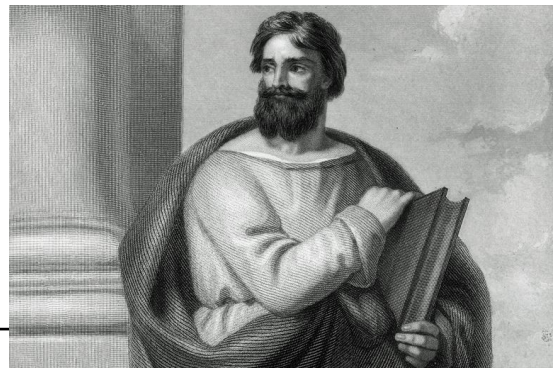

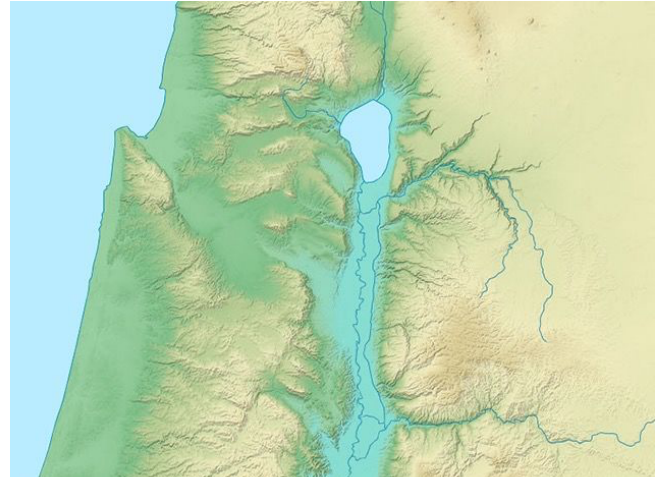

## LUKE 7:1-35

### JESUS HEALS A CENTURION'S SERVANT (VV. 1-10)

- Where is Capernaum?
- What is a centurion?
  - What does Matt. 8:6 say was wrong with his slave?
  - What is his likely nationality?
- Who did the centurion ask to seek for help from Jesus?
  - Why were they willing to do this for the centurion?
- When Jesus came near the house, what happened?
  - What was the centurion's motivation for doing this?
  - What was the centurion's reasoning for this request?

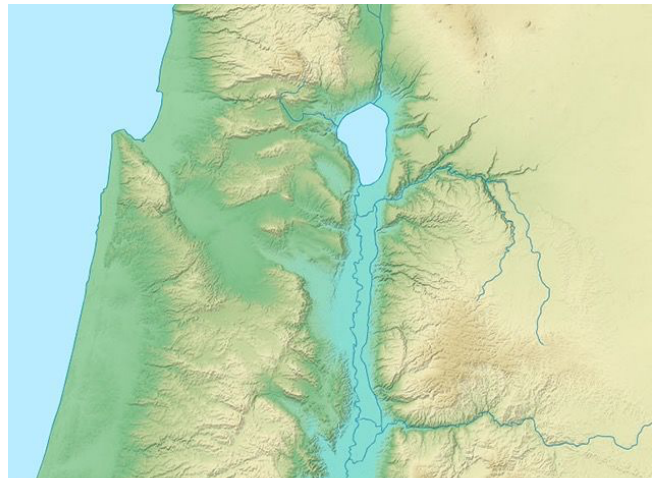


- What made this so amazing to Jesus?
- When the friends returned to the house, what did they find out about the centurion's servant?
- What does this teach us?

## **A MIRACLE IN NAIN (VV. 11 - 17)**

- Where is Nain?
- What did Jesus encounter when he entered the town?
  - What made this funeral so sad?
- What did Jesus do?
  - What did Jesus say?
  - What happened next?
- What was the reaction of the crowd? (How would you have felt?)
  - What did they begin to say about Him?
- Why do you think Jesus didn't raise every dead person in Israel?



- Why do you think Jesus didn't heal every sick person in Israel?
- Was Jesus not compassionate?
- What was the main reason for the miracles?

## **VISITORS FROM JOHN (VV. 18-35)**

- Where was John at this point?
  - Why?
- What was John's question sent to Jesus?
  - How did John ask this question?
  - He asked this question in response to what?
  - Isn't this the same John that baptized Jesus?
  - Why is he asking this question of Jesus?
- What was Jesus' "answer"?
  - Why did Jesus answer this way rather than a straightforward acknowledgment?
  - What did Jesus mean by, "Blessed is he who does not take offense at Me"?
- What did Jesus mean...?

- “What did you go out into the wilderness to see? A reed shaken by the wind?”
- “A man dressed in self clothing? Those who are splendidly clothed and live in luxury are found in royal palaces!”
- “A prophet? Yes, I say to you, and more than a prophet.”
- What was John’s mission? (v. 27)
  - What made John so great?
  - Why is the one who is least in the Kingdom greater than John the Baptist?
- What was God’s purpose for the tax gatherers, Pharisees, and lawyers?
  - What was John’s baptism for? (Acts 19:4)
- What was the meaning of Jesus’ parable of the children in the market place?
  - What did they want of John the Baptist?
  - What did they want of Jesus?
  - What does it mean that wisdom is vindicated by all her children?
