"We're Here and We Care"

GOD'S PLAN — PART 25

The redemption from our sin is in Christ Jesus, and available only through the Plan that God Himself has prepared. The world teaches that salvation comes to us because of the shed blood of Christ, when in reality, it is the shed blood of Jesus Christ that purchased the Plan that God prepared. Salvation came not when Christ died upon the cross, but without His sacrifice, the Plan could not have been completed! The mis-representation that belief in Christ alone brings us to salvation is Satan's greatest lie since the Garden.

'The Faith' exemplified in <u>Hebrews 11</u> does not stress "faith only" but the acceptance of God's Plan without exception. Obviously, the abbreviated version is Hear-Believe-Repent-Confess and Baptism. This is predicated by <u>Hebrews</u> 11:6, "without faith, it is impossible to please Him; for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him." <u>2 Timothy 2:15</u> must enter into the equation which says, "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth."

It is a requirement to study the Scriptures. We must know HOW to please Him. This is the importance of understanding well what the intended Plan is by virtue of the inspired word that was provided for this purpose. From <u>Matthew 4:17</u>, Jesus began to preach regarding the "Kingdom to come". Mark wrote <u>Mark 9:1</u>, "there be <u>some of them that stand here</u>, which shall not taste death until they have seen the Kingdom of God come with Power." The days of fulfillment of prophecy concerning the Church and the Kingdom were eminent. The actual record is included in **Acts 2**.

Jesus revealed the next significant part of the Plan in <u>Matthew 16:18-19</u>. Although the Apostles would not comprehend the total implication of what they wrote. It was not necessary at the time. <u>John 7:39</u> gives a partial explanation why it was not important yet, and then confirmed by Jesus in <u>Acts 2:33</u>. John wrote, "this spake He of the Holy Ghost... which was not yet given; because that Jesus had not yet been glorified." Peter wrote (of Jesus) in <u>Acts 2:33</u>, "being by the right hand of God, exalted, and having received the promise of the Holy Ghost, He hath shed forth this which ye now see and hear." urs is a time in which religious differences are usually met with indifference (pun intended). People may be adamant about politics, sports teams, music, fashion and any number of other things; but frequently not about religion. This has produced a "whatever" kind of attitude toward doctrine, truth, morality, and even the divinely drawn line between lost and saved. And it is this last matter, the "whatever" attitude toward the line between the lost and the saved, that has led many to

believe that indiscriminate attendance to any assembly that wears the name "church" is OK. It's not, and here are some of the reasons why.

In Ezra 4 the Samaritans came to Jerusalem to offer help rebuilding the Lord's destroyed temple, saying "...we, like you, seek your God; and we have been sacrificing to Him

since the days of Esarhaddon king of Assyria, who brought us here."Perhaps surprising to us, Zerubbabel, Jeshua, and the rest of the fathers' household of Israel rightly told them, "You have nothing in common with us in building a house to our God..." They may have been trying worship the right God; but first of all, they weren't in covenant with God, two, they weren't worshipping the right way, and three, they were also worshipping their former gods (1 Kings 17:25-36). God's people would have sinned to worship with those who were not His people and were not worshipping Him the right way; and it would not be right for us today.

It does matter who you worship with. Many assemblies that claim to be a church are not churches by God's definition. As you sit in such an assembly you may partake in a bread and fruit of the vine ceremony, you may pray, give, listen to a lesson from the Bible, and may (rarely) even sing a cappella; but if the general assembly have not been baptized, they are not saved, not Christians and not the church —

and the Hebrews 10:25 command to assemble is a call to worship with the *Lord's* church.

When I say that they are not Christians and are not the church, I am not trying to insult anyone; rather, I am humbly trying to point out an important truth, that many religious groups who post a sign that reads "church" out front are not the Bible's definition of a church. Many (many) have come up short of the Lord's command to be baptized in Christ's name for forgiveness of sin (Acts 2:38), opting for "faith alone"

or "the sinners prayer"; and have therefore come up short of the biblical definition of being saved (1 Peter 3:21); and have therefore come short of God's definition of the Lord's church (Acts 2:47).

dard definition for being a "gentle-

resources, you needed to own land, and you needed to have some political clout. If you did not meet those standards, there was no insult or offense taken to hear some say, "Sir, you are not a gentleman." But the definition of "gentleman" has evolved to the point that today the same sentence would be saying that the man was simply rude and unmannered an insult. Similarly the definition of church and Christian has changed and broadened to include any person or group of people who believe in Jesus (and oddly enough, even a few who don't). But God's definition (to be a Christian you must be baptized) stands unchanged and it is God's unchanged definition that will count on the Last Day.

So, when you worship on Sunday, worship with God's definition of the church, with God's definition of your brothers and sisters in Christ, with God's definition of worship in truth (God's commanded worship) and God's definition of worship in spirit (in God's commanded way). That's the way to get the very most out of worship, and leaving the assembly uplifted and filled and ready for the week ahead.
